

During the Gandhara Symposium, a draft of Takshashila Declaration, in connection with the ancient name of Pakistani city Taxila and center of Gandhara, was drafted and shared with the monks and embassies to strengthen bilateral Cooperation on the subject matter.

I believe that with the promotion of Gandhara tourism under PM Task Force, in a short period of time, Pakistan can earn a large amount of foreign exchange and also get rid of foreign debts of time. Moreover, it will help to improve Pakistan's image at national and international levels.

Founded in 2005 by Dr. Ramesh Kumar Vankwani with the vision of becoming a beacon of hope and support not only for the Hindu individuals but for all the underprivileged communities in Pakistan. It is engaged in various activities like organizing conferences, events to promote and strengthen unity among Pakistani society. The council strives to address social, economic and cultural challenges fostering inclusivity and empowerment for all individuals irrespective of their religious backgrounds.

Aims & Objectives

 cultural centers Pathshalas, and Dharamshallas etc.
- To establish centers for building noble character in the young generation for promotion of Hindu culture and ideology.
- To establish charitable hospitals, clinics, dispensaries, Blood Banks, Health Centers, Laboratories, etc and also to establish centers for the physical, mental, literary and moral development and to arrange training programs.
- To promote close contacts for identity of views, friendly relations and sense of unity and fraternity among the fellow members specifically and Hindus Community in general.
- To adopt ways and means for the promotion of education and economic prosperity in Hindu Community and to establish manage and support educational institutions for the promotion of modern education such as computers, IT and Vedic studies, all Hindu scriptures and oriental sciences etc.

- To assist and co-operate with other Associations, Panchayats and Organizations, having similar charter, in the pursuit of the foregoing aims and objects.
- To undertake and to perform all such other lawful activities as may be instrumental and conducive for the attainment of any of the foregoing aims.
- To inculcate, foster and stimulate the spirit of mutual self-help on principal of co-operation and coordination among the fellow members.
- To extend immediate help in case of any specific problem confronting any faction of the community beyond their local reach.
- To extend help for the promotion of cause of Education from primary level to university level especially among poor factions of community throughout Pakistan, by way of awarding scholarships and providing books, uniforms etc.
- To protect the existing institutions, schools, cremation grounds, graveyards, Hindu Trust Properties,
 Pathshalas, gymkhana & other Hindu places.
- To celebrate and assist the Hindu community for celebration of welfare festivals for developing sense of unity.
- To help and work for the promotion of such schemes of charity for the welfare and social uplift of the community, particularly in poor faction of the society.
- To obtain and accept subscriptions, donations, grants and gifts, and any other help from individuals, firms, Govt. and semi Govt. organizations, NGO's, and other institutions, local Government etc..
- The Council shall be run on non-political, non-religious and non-commercial basis.
- The promoter/office bearer and members shall not be paid employees of the Association, in any form whatsoever.
- To ensure, receive, accept and manage funds, donations, grant endowments and any other movable and immovable properties from lawful sources within a country and to utilize them for enhancing and promoting the aims and objects enunciated herein.
- The Council shall confine its activities only to the aims and objects of the Council and the income
 and property of the Council from whatever sources derived shall be applied solely towards the
 promotion of the objects of the Council and no portion thereof shall be paid by way of dividend /
 Profit and bonus to any member / office bearers or otherwise. Violation of this condition will be
 personal responsibility of the office bearers or members concerned.
- To help and encourage the institutions working for Hindu matrimonial system for arranging group marriages and also to arrange such group marriages of poor faction of Hindu Community.

WHAT WE DO

Combined Marriages

Combined marriages program is a commendable initiative started in 2008 by Pakistan Hindu Council. The vision and the purpose of this initiative is to reach out to the underprivileged individuals of the society from all over Pakistan. Designed to alleviate financial burdens and provide a dignified start to their marital journey, this program offers support to the couples who may otherwise struggle to afford a wedding ceremony. It is one of the biggest yearly event that Pakistan Hindu Council has been arranging since 2008. In this event almost 100 couples tie the knot from all over Pakistan. All the expenses are borne by the Pakistan Hindu Council and more than 1500 families have been supported through this event during a span of 17 years. In this event a large number of people participate from all across the country belonging to different walks of life.

Schools

Education is one of the key areas on which Pakistan Hindu Council keeps focus on. Pakistan Hindu Council has the aim of uplifting the deprived communities through education. Currently, we have around 17 primary schools. These schools are being managed across Tharparkar where course books, uniform, shoes and other stationary are also provided to students free of cost. The school organizes different activities and informative programs for students and teachers for enhancing their skills and understanding.

Ambulance Services

The Pakistan Hindu Council is known for its commitment in providing crucial healthcare services to communities in need. Among its notable initiatives the organization runs a total of 16 ambulances catering to the medical needs of individuals from all across the region. This service caters to everyone irrespective of their faith and religious backgrounds.

Coffin Carrier

Pakistan Hindu Council runs 2 well equipped Coffin Carrier buses one of them being catered to the people of Karachi and the other in Hyderabad.

Financial Assistance Help

Every year the Pakistan Hindu Council gives financial support to the poor and underprivileged to uplift them economically. In this program more than 1000 individuals are supported every year. This Financial support can be for different purposes such as Medical, Marriage, and Education etc.

Rozgar Schemes

Through our Rozgar Scheme we aim to provide employment to the youth by providing them with Rikshaws so they are able to earn their own livlihood. We have distributed around 125 Qingqi Rikshaws to the needy youth of Pakistan to encourage them to earn their own livelihood and run their household.

Wheelchair Distribution Program

Pakistan Hindu Council aims to provide a better life to the differently-abled individuals of the society. We have distributed thousands of wheelchairs to the differently-aled needy individuals since 2008.

Women Empowerment

Pakistan Hindu Council has been offering sewing machines to the needy Hindu women specially orphans and widows to provide them opportunities to create, learn new skills, build self-confidence, and contribute to their own livelihoods and the well being of their families. Since 2005, we have distributed more than thousands of sewing machines across the country and empowering the Hindu women to become self sustaining. Pakistan Hindu Council also runs vocational centers for women in Umerkot and Chelhar.

Jeevan Ka Sathi

Jeevan Ka Sathi marriage bureau of Pakistan Hindu Council is a renowned matchmaking service in Pakistan which is totally committed to helping Hindu individuals find sutable life partners. Started in 2021, uptil now more than 200 couples have been connected through this platform.

Jeevan Ka Sathi Mobile App

Pakistan Hindu Council has introduced its Matrimony Application Jeevan Ka Sathi enabling the individuals to explore potential life partners conveniently through their smartphones. This digital initiative underscores the Council's commitment to embracing technological advancements and fostering a modern approach to facilitate meaningful relationships within the Hindu community.

Mata Sarasvati Scholarship

The Mata Sarasvati Scholarship Program, initiated by the Pakistan Hindu Council, is an endeavor aimed at providing educational support to female students in schools and colleges. This scholarship program, named after the Hindu goddess of knowledge, Mata Sarasvati, emphasizes the importance of empowering young girls through education. By offering financial assistance and resources, the program endeavors to foster academic excellence and create opportunities for the advancement of young female students within the Hindu community in Pakistan.

PHC Internship Program

The PHC Internship Program, is an opportunity for the undergraduates to provide them with valuable hands-on experience and professional development within the realm of community service and advocacy. This program aims to nurture young talent by offering them practical exposure to various aspects of organizational management and social initiatives.

Job Fair
